BECOME A HOST EMPLOYER TODAY! Our Field Placement Team at SGSCC collaborates with our host employers to provide an experience for students, that meets the student's course requirements. The aim is to expose students to the industry of their choice, tailoring an experience based on individual host employers. Our team provides the host employer with schedules for students and dates for assessments, conducted by our skilled Field Placement Assessors.

All our students have obtained a Police Check, Working with Children Check (for organisations that require it), and any immunisation requirements. During the student's time at placement, each student will work through a workbook to journal their experiences and log their hours. This is checked by our Field Placement Assessor during on-site assessments and signed by the host employer.

What is exciting for the students is exposure to the industry. We like to adapt their experiences during field placement to the required learning, as everyone's experience is different. Our Field Placement Assessors conduct their student assessing around the host employers' programs/needs, ensuring there is no disruption to service delivery, respecting client privacy.

SGSCC partners with many host employers as an employment pathway for recruitment.
