

FIRST AID COURSES

Learning basic first aid techniques can help you cope with an emergency. You may be able to keep a person breathing, reduce their pain or minimise the consequences of injury or sudden illness until an ambulance arrives. Must be working in the industry to enrol in this course or have a current CHC52015 Diploma of Community Services.

This qualification is specifically designed to give you the right skills and knowledge to work with people and assist them in seeking solutions to a range of personal and social issues. Mental health workers assist those living with a mental illness and other areas within the community. Students must hold a current CHC43315 Certificate IV in Mental Health to enrol in this course. 


